Q&A

The Little League All-Star tournament is the most widely known youth sports tournament in the world. This season, on the baseball side, Dr. Phillips Little League will have opportunities for players leagues ages 8 to 14 to earn roster spots on five different All-Star teams!

The tournaments start at the District level, and teams must win their way to advance through the International Tournament. It all starts with the 8-9 All-Stars, which is a District-only tournament. The 8-10 All-Stars and 9-11 All-Stars offer tournaments which culminate at the State Level. And the Little League All-Stars and Juniors All-Stars both conclude at a World Series Tournament.

So here's everything you need to know about this season's All-Star tournaments...

Q: How many All-Star teams will Dr. Phillips Little League have this season?

A: Five. They are as follows:

8-9 All-Stars

League Ages 8 & 9

District-only tournament

Start date: Thursday, June 2nd

8-10 All-Stars

League Ages 8, 9, & 10

Start date: Friday, June 17th

9-11 All-Stars

League Ages 9, 10 & 11

Start date: Friday, June 17th



Little League All-Stars

League Ages 10, 11 & 12

Start date: Friday, June 24th

Juniors All-Stars

League Ages 13 & 14 (league age 15s are not eligible)

Start date: Friday, June 24th

Q: Where will each All-Star tournament be played?

A: The locations of each tournament will be announced within the next couple of weeks. Each All-Star tournament will be hosted by one of the five leagues in our District: Windermere LL, Winter Garden LL, South Lake LL, Apopka LL and Dr. Phillips Little League.

8-9 All Stars: Apopka LL

8-10 All Stars: DPLL

9-11 All Stars: DPLL

Little League All Stars: Windermere LL

Juniors All Stars: Windermere LL

Q: How does my son declare for All-Stars?

A: Any player wishing to declare themselves as an All-Star candidate must complete an on-line All-Star declaration. The declaration portal is found on our website (www.dpll.org) and will be available starting today, April 4th and will be open until Friday, April 22nd at 5PM.

Simply login to your account and select the "Register Now" button in the upper right-hand corner.

The All-Star declaration process will include:

- Selection of declared All-Star team (player can declare for two All-Star teams)
- Answering questions relating to the commitment of All-Stars
- Upload necessary residency documentation



- Upload a copy of player's birth certificate
- The declaration does **not** guarantee an All-Star roster spot
- Eligible criteria for players are addressed in the Official Little League Rulebook under "Tournament Rules and Guidelines"

Q: How are the All-Star teams selected?

A: For the following teams, the manager and assistant coaches in certain divisions vote and select the top 10 players on an All-Star team:

8-9 All-Stars, 8-10 All-Stars, 9-11 All-Stars, & Juniors All-Stars

The All-Star manager then selects the remainder of the team's roster (2-4 additional players)

For Little League All-Stars, the players from each Majors team, the manager and assistant coaches from the Majors division select the top 10 players. The All-Star manager then selects the remainder of the team's roster (2-4 additional players)

Is there a cost to declare for All-Stars?

No, there is not a cost to declare for an All-Star team. However, if your son is selected to an All-Star team, the fee is \$125, which covers the cost of uniforms (2 custom DPLL All-Star jerseys, pants, custom DPLL socks, belt and custom DPLL All-Star hat)

Q: When will we find out who made DPLL's All-Star teams?

A: We will announce the rosters of all five DPLL All-Star teams on Sunday, May 15th, via email blast and our league Social Media accounts.
